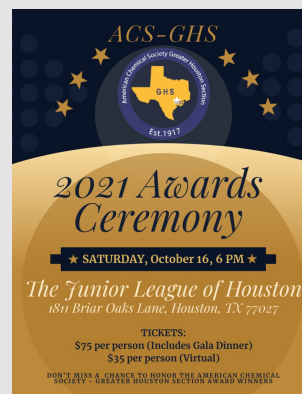

STEM Excitement for the Whole Family!

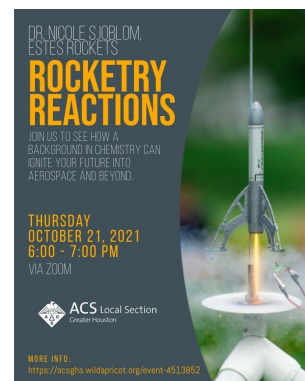

Save the Date: November Seminar

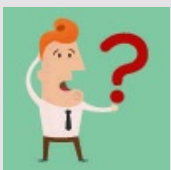
